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Pawsitively Social Emotional Learning Curriculum Empathy

Definition:

Empathy is the experience of understanding another person's thoughts, feelings, and condition from their point of view, rather than from your own. You try to imagine yourself in their place in order to understand what they are feeling or experiencing.

Helpful Vocabulary:

Empathy is easily confused with sympathy. One is better able to practice empathy if the differences are understood.

When we are **sympathetic** we feel:

- Concern for another person that is in an unfortunate situation or is emotionally hurt.
- Often a feeling of pity.
 - "I see a homeless person and I feel sorry for them."

When we are **empathetic** we feel:

- We can feel what someone else is feeling.
- We see something from another person's perspective putting yourself in their shoes.
 - "I see a person who has been in a car accident and I feel empathy for them because I also have been in a car accident. I know what they are feeling and going through."

Benefits of Teaching Empathy:

Children are born with the capacity for empathy, but it needs to be nurtured throughout their lives. Learning empathy is in certain respects like learning a language or a sport. It requires practice and guidance. Regularly considering other people's perspectives and circumstances helps make empathy a natural reflex and, through trial and error, helps children get better at tuning into others' feelings and perspectives. Children learn empathy both from watching us and from experiencing our empathy for them. When we empathize with our children they develop trusting, secure attachments with us. Those attachments are key to their wanting to adopt our values and to model our behavior, and therefore to building their empathy for others.

Here are just some of the benefits to helping your child/children practice empathy.

- It helps to build strong, lasting relationships.
- It encourages a loving attitude.
- It is linked with increased happiness and scholastic achievement.
- It is a key to prevent bullying and other cruel behaviors.
